



The [New Jersey Youth Corps](#) offered by Project Self-Sufficiency gives Sussex and Warren County residents, ages 16 - 25, the opportunity to:

- Prepare for the high school equivalency exam;
- Boost literacy skills;
- Obtain on-the-job work experience;
- Receive counseling and support services;
- Collect a stipend of \$100 per week, based on attendance for the full week;
- Access free transportation;
- Receive free childcare at the Little Sprouts Early Learning Center;
- Transition into a career, college or the military.

The free, sixteen-week program runs year-round, Monday - Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Participants must be Sussex or Warren County residents, aged 16 - 25, who have not completed high school.

The program includes assessments, testing, employability skills training, life skills workshops, academic instruction, community service projects, field trips, and counseling services. Funded by the New Jersey Department of Labor & Workforce Development.

Know someone who is eligible? Refer an eligible individual and receive a \$100 gift card! Referred individuals must enroll in the program, complete the 2-week orientation, and be inducted into the program.
