

Tuesday March 6 Update

Apologies for the delay in posting today's updates.

Today we've had a large number of JCPL trucks in town opening roads, moving downed wires and restoring power. We do not have exact numbers but it appears that around half of the residences in Town are still without power at this time. JCPL crews are working into the night and hopefully will bring more of us back on line before the snow arrives tomorrow.

Unfortunately a major winter storm is scheduled to begin tonight that could deliver 10 to 16 inches of snow. Most of the township's roads have been cleared of trees and downed wires to allow our road department to plow but please wait until the roads have been cleared before driving.

Based on this weather forecast, Town hall may be closed tomorrow depending on road conditions. The monthly meeting of the Hardwick Township Committee will be rescheduled.

Depending on road conditions, we might have a delayed opening for the warming center and charging station. We will take a wait and see approach, gauge road conditions and the amount of snow and make a decision on opening the building. If we can open, water donated by Mountainwood Springs here in Hardwick will be available.

We will post updates here tomorrow on the Hardwick Township website and on local social media sites. Please check local social media sites for updated information regarding the hours that the North Warren warming center will be open.
